SB said that Manea hall insurance would not cover our equipment stored there. SH pointed out that we are not insured for transit of equipment to Have A Go days etc and that the 2<sup>nd</sup> company could possibly cover this for a fee. There was discussion about premiums and types of insurance. Wait for quote from 2<sup>nd</sup> company.

At the last meeting SG agreed to check exact details on vulnerable adults. SB had looked into it instead and reported that one to one situations should be avoided.

SG will get keys to the gate for when we start shooting in the evenings again.
