Approval of Minutes

Treasurers Report

Everything is fine at present, although the committee were made aware of the fact up to 10 new targets will need to be purchased for next years outdoor season at an approximate cost of £1200.

Records Officers Report

Now up to date. It was decided that due to the low number of members that had completed the necessary number of rounds for the Summer Sizzler, namely 2 people, that this year it would include any rounds shot during July and August, but only those shot at Parkfield.

Fundraising Report

Press Officer

The committee members did not see this as an issue, as during the rest of the year the club had received plenty of publicity and with the indoor season approaching and not being able to run beginners courses this was not a problem. He did say that provided he was advised by somebody who attended the event he would still be able to submit a report, but it must be provided the same weekend.

The Junior reps were pleased to see that there had been an increase in the number of junior members following their completion of the beginners courses.

Any Other Business and Correspondence

Rick confirmed that his payment for the Level 1 Coaching Course had been accepted and will commence shortly. He will also need to complete the Child Protection and First Aid Courses, which he has in hand. The committee also agreed that they would pay Rick a mileage allowance for attending the coaching course.

Rick had also recently attended the CAA AGM, where it was advised that further Level 1 Coaching Courses will be run within the county in March and August next year. Also it had been discussed regarding the matter of County Records were other clubs had submitted records from normal club evenings. It was therefore confirmed that only scores shot in a tournament under GNAS/FITA rules and where another archer had recorded the scores would qualify for a county record. We had received an email via the website asking if we wished to be registered on a new Sport Listing site – it was agreed not to pursue this to minimise the risk of spam emails to the club. Living Sport advised that the clubs submission for Harry Silvester in a County Sport Award had been unsuccessful.

James noted that we are still awaiting payment for hosting the End of Season Tournament.
