**Chairman's Report**

Steve was not able to attend, as he was ill.

**Secretary**

Steven to ask Steve Greene if he will still stand as chairman even though he won't be able to attend very often.

Steven and Geoff to send out letter, agenda and possible membership fee information to members in advance of AGM.

Junior club looks simple to setup. Roger to ask Jonathan Adlem what steps Ely took and if a separate committee is necessary.

We are all reminded that we must have at least 25 yards (GNAS Rule) between the last butt and the flags and warning signs. We must also make sure that on days when we have two shooting lines running (such as beginners, and the rest of the club, or private practice) that we must make sure there is ample distance between them.

Ely Archers have asked if we would loan them 10 butts for the East Anglian Champs. It was agreed to do this at the suggested fee of £10/butt.

**Treasurer**

Presented accounts and suggested membership fees taking into account rental of an additional field at Manea. (Will be discussed and voted on at the AGM). The majority of the committee voted in favour of the proposal.

Steve Bullman pointed out that some Norfolk clubs have paid some or all of the entrance fees for their juniors at National shoots and would it be possible for Parkfield Archers to do similar.

If possible a calendar of shoots will be produced and where possible will try to fit around peoples holidays.

Steve Bullman reported that members had asked if the club could have an independent Press Officer. There was also discussion about regular columns in local papers, but it was felt there was probably not enough to report on each week.

There was discussion that we should run some events to raise money for the club this year.

There is the possibility of away (weekend) shoots at Cromer, Lowestoft and Southwold maybe.

Need somewhere to display our club trophies – the trophy cabinets should be going back up at Parkfield.

Ely archers will be organising some junior coaching sessions in the near future.
