Matters Arising

Treasurer

There is a predicted shortfall in the club accounts due to increases in field costs at Parkfield Sports Club. This will possibly mean an increase in shooting fees or a reduction in numbers of shooting nights indoors.

Proposed Club Competitions

A list of proposed club competition for 2012 was discussed, the proposed list was agreed and will be circulated with the AGM invites.

Alex discussed changing the way the Summer Sizzler competition is run. The competition will now consist of shooting any appropriate 6 dozen rounds with an average of rounds shot being used to decide the winner.

The Open was set for the 10th June and Richard is going to contact Wayne for details on how to book judges and look at trophies for the event.
