Minutes of Committee Meeting held at Mauea Village Hall - Tuesday 11 January 2005

Meeting Opened: 08.15pm

The chairman opened the meeting by firstly thanking everyone for attending and then the following items were discussed:

Ground Fees - Parkfield Archers have recently received a letter From Parkfield Sports and Social Club Vice Chairman advising that in order for them to remain viable they are introducing Ground Fees (payable as from 1st January 2005). The Fees also apply to the cricket and football clubs.

The fees payable by Parkfield Archers, £10 for a Saturday/Sunday respectively and £5 for each evening were set by Parkfield Sports and Social committee and are not negotiable.

A number of options were explored and it was decided that the ground fees payable were reasonable and the club should continue shooting on the sports field. Projected figures suggest Parkfield Archers can currently cover the cost of the fees without making additional charges to its members by diverting some of the money collected for target fees to cover the cost of ground fees. Obviously this will be monitored and re-assessed at a later date if necessary.

A letter has been sent to Parkfield Sports and Social Vice Chairman agreeing to the charges and also asking for clarification on a few points.
